## India warns against "double standards" over Russian oil

# India warns against 'double standards' over Russian oil

Centre responds to U.S. Bill seeking to impose duties on countries buying Russian oil, and threat from NATO chief; Petroleum Minister says the sanctions will be 'dealt with' when they are passed

ndia on Thursday cautioned against "double standards", even as U.S. lawmakers consider a Bill that would impose 500% duties on India and other countries buying Russian oil.

The comments by the External Affairs Ministry come after indications that U.S. President Donald Trump is backing the Russian Sanctions Act, 2025, introduced by Republican Senator Lindsey Graham. Mr. Trump had even threatened secondary tariffs of 100% on countries that continue trade on sanctioned Russian products.

the U.S. Congress, also issued a threat, in particular to China, India, and Brazil, who are among the top buyers of Russian crude oil, oil products, and coal. "Beijing and Delhi" should push Russian President Vladimir Putin towards ending the war in Ukraine, or face tariffs, the chief of

the military alliance said.
Responding to questions on the issue, the External Affairs Ministry said it was following the developments closely. "Securing the energy needs of our

people is understandably an overriding priority for us. In this endeavour, we are guided by what is there on offer in the markets, as also by the prevailing global circumstances," spokesperson Randhir Jaiswal said. "We would particularly caution against any double standards on the matter," he added.

#### 'Diverse sources'


At an industry event in Delhi on Thursday, Union Petroleum Minister Hardeep Puri said India would "deal" with sanctions when they are passed, pointing out that India has diversified its supply sources, buying oil from about 40 countries now, as opposed to 27 in the past.

**Refinery expansion plans:** India's current refining capacity is 257 mt per annum, expected to grow further.

# Akash Prime successfully tested in Ladakh by Army

To further strengthen the air defence system, the Army has carried out successful trials of the indigenously developed air defence system "Akash Prime" in Ladakh.

A senior official confirmed that the Army Air Defence Corps conducted the trials in collaboration with senior scientists from the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO), which developed the missile system.

The two-day trial was conducted at an altitude of over 15,000 feet in eastern Ladakh. The Akash Prime scored two direct hits on fast-moving aerial targets in the rarefied high-altitude atmosphere.

The latest version of the Akash system would form the third and fourth regiments of the Akash air defence systems in the Indian Army. The Akash air defence system is a mediumrange, surface-to-air missile platform.

**Prithvi-II and Agni-I** The Ministry of Defence on Thursday confirmed that short-range ballistic missiles – Prithvi-II and Agni-I – were successfully test-fired from the Integrated Test Range in Chandipur, Odisha.

The launches validated all operational and technical parameters. These tests were conducted under the aegis of the Strategic Forces Command, added the Ministry.

**About POSHAN Abhiyan** 

It is a flagship **initiative of the Ministry of Women and Child Development,** launched on
8th March 2018 in Jhunjhunu, Rajasthan.

The program aims to address the nutrition needs of adolescent girls, pregnant women, lactating mothers, and children (0-6 years) through a targeted and convergent approach.

#### **Objectives of POSHAN Abhiyaan**

It aims to reduce stunting, undernutrition, anaemia (among young children, women and adolescent girls) and reduce low birth weight by 2%, 2%, 3% and 2% per annum respectively.

Strategic Pillars: It operates through four strategic pillars:

**Quality Services:** Strengthens health services via **ICDS, NHM, PMMVY,** focusing on a child's first **1,000 days**.

Cross-Sectoral Convergence: Integrates ministries like Water & Sanitation for holistic nutrition.

The National Council on India's Nutritional Challenges, led by NITI Aayog, guides policy and reviews nutrition convergence quarterly.

Strategic Pillars: It operates through four strategic pillars:

**Technology:** Uses the **Poshan Tracker** for realtime data and monitoring and **ICDS-Common Application Software** to strengthen delivery of Anganwadi Services.

Jan Andolan: Promotes community-led nutrition awareness and behavioral change.

Mission Saksham Anganwadi and Poshan 2.0

It is also known as Mission Poshan 2.0, that fosters health, wellness, and immunity and infrastructure upgrades for Anganwadi Centre (AWCs) e.g., dedicated buildings, functional toilets, with drinking water access.

# PNGRB asks city gas firms to supply piped gas to all households at uniform rate

The Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (PNGRB) directed city gas distribution (CGD) entities to supply piped natural gas at a uniform rate to all domestic household consumers, irrespective of daily consumption levels.

The oil regulator said this while taking note of a telescopic pricing structure for the gas supply to domestic consumers that certain CGD entities were implementing in which the per standard cubic metre (SCM) price of the commodity escalated as consumption crossed a predefined threshold.



The directive comes in context of a telescopic pricing by CGDs.

"Such pricing practices may inadvertently facilitate unauthorised use of subsidised APM (administered pricing mechanism) gas by commercial consumers who may be misclassified as domestic consumers. Additionally, genuine domestic consum

ers with higher consumption levels may be unfairly subjected to elevated charges, despite natural gas being supplied to CGD entities at a uniform APM rate." PNGRB said.

#### Thorough review

It advised CGD firms to undertake a 'thorough review of consumption patterns and investigate anomalous cases where domestic consumers exhibit significantly higher usage relative to industry average and take corrective measures.

It also cited government norms where natural gas is allocated at concessional rates to boost its adoption by households and the transport sector.
